



Measures of Academic Progress

Our first round of Measures of Academic Progress (MAP) testing is nearing completion for our students in K2 – grade 8. We are now working on individual students who either missed a test or did not finish, and our plan is to complete this by the end of next week. As a reminder, you will not receive individual student reports from this first round of testing since it is intended to provide a baseline from which we will measure growth throughout the school year. After our administration of the second round of MAP testing in late January/early February, you will receive a report regarding your child's achievement and growth to that point (Fall 2016 - Winter 2017 comparison). Our final round of testing will be conducted in May and you will receive a summary report of testing results for the entire school year (Fall 2016 – Spring 2017 comparison). A detailed explanation of how to read and understand the results will be shared with you when we send home the individual student reports after our second round of testing.
