

**** CRITICAL NOTICE REGARDING SCHOOL DROP-OFF AND PICK-UP ****
Effective September 6, 2017 until further notice

Earlier this summer, construction on the Church steeple was initiated to address issues due to water damage. Though the construction crew has made good progress, the work will not be finished prior to the start of the school year...and it will most likely continue for another 2-4 weeks. As a result, it is necessary for us to make the following temporary changes to the school drop-off procedures.

MORNING DROP-OFF

The Washington Street entrance will be inaccessible for morning drop-off because the construction crew will be using that area for staging. We will be using the parking spaces on Commercial Street to facilitate rolling drop-off, so parking on the school side of Commercial Street in the morning is strictly prohibited.

Rolling drop-off for students in K2 - grade 8 will be conducted in front of the school on the school-side of Commercial Street. All cars participating in rolling drop-off should approach the school from the intersection of Washington and Commercial. Weymouth police officers and school staff will be on hand to assist in getting students out of cars. Please take care to position your children on the right-hand side of the car. As students are dropped off, they will go directly into the school building and into their classrooms.

* Parents who plan to park their cars and walk their children to school may park on Prospect Street or in the Lucid Funeral Home parking lot on Washington Street. If parking, please note that you may not walk through the parking lot at the Washington Street entrance (construction crew will be working). You will need to follow the sidewalk down Washington Street to the intersection, then turn right onto the Commercial Street sidewalk.

Drop-off for PreK and K1 students will be conducted in the back schoolyard. Please enter the parking lot via Commercial Street and follow the cones to the back schoolyard. Please park your car and walk your children to their teacher. As they are received by their teachers, students will be brought safely into their classrooms. Mr. Daniel McCarthy, Mr. Patrick McCarthy, and our PreK and K1 staff will facilitate the back schoolyard dropoff.

Accessible Parking is available in front of the rectory only for those vehicles that have a valid Massachusetts accessible hangtag.

Special Note for PreK, K1, and K2 Orientation on Wednesday, 9/6 and Thursday, 9/7

PreK and K1 parents should park in the back schoolyard for orientation sessions. Please enter the parking lot via Commercial Street and follow the cones to the back schoolyard.

AFTERNOON PICK-UP

Each day, the construction crew will complete its work and vacate the parking lot no later than 2:15 pm. Therefore, cars should enter the parking lot in the regular manner (via Washington Street). Parking spaces on Commercial Street will be re-opened each afternoon.
